## Saturday, May 09 – 5K Elite/Open & Youth Fun Run

- Westmorland, York, and Carleton Streets from King to Queen Street
- Expect delays and restricted entry downtown
- Plan extra travel time and consider approaching via an alternate route from the course.

#### Street Closure Notice (10:00 – 11:00)

- Queen Street from Regent Street to Westmorland Street
  - York and Carleton Streets from King to Queen Street
  - Expect delays and restricted entry to Queen Street, from Regent to Westmorland Street
  - Plan extra travel time and consider approaching via an alternate route from the course.

- East End Downtown road closures from 06:15 to 09:30 may affect access to parking
- Expect delays and restricted entry to Queen Street, Saint John Street, and the surrounding areas
- Plan extra travel time and consider approaching via an alternate route from the course
